


Baby Dance

Let's Dance!




Follow these steps...



You will need scissors and tape or glue.

Cut out the dice.



You are what interests your baby most. Playing and moving together is a wonderful way to bond with your baby.

Fold along the dots to make a cube.

Stick or glue tabs and roll the dice!



Show your child the dice once it's made. Talk about the animals on the sides and wave or throw the dice in the air to grab their attention.
