Who is in your family?

You will need:

- Photo frame template
- · Pens, textas, crayons and pencils
- Sticky tape or a glue stick.

What to do

- 1. Colour in and decorate the photo frame template using your colour pencils, textas, crayons or pens.
- 2. Collect photos from around your home, or print some new photos, of all your family members. These could be relatives, carers, friends or even pets!
- 3. Collage and stick the images in the photo frame template. Write the names of your family next to each of the photos.
- 4. While you write each name down, talk with your child about all the special people in your family. Talk about memories or share funny stories. What does your family do together that is special?

More ideas

You can ask your child questions about who each family member is. 'Who is this?' Is that Grandma? What do you like to do together with Grandma?'. You can also talk about different types of families with your toddler.

Not all families look the same and every family is unique! Ask them questions about how your family is the same or different from other friends or the family in the story.
